New & Improved Attendance Notifications

from Comsewogue School District

What's Changed?

Beginning February 29, 2024, Comsewogue School District has enabled email and SMS (text message) notifications when your child is marked absent from school. You will also continue to receive absence notifications for your child via an automated voice call.

Setting Attendance Notifications Preferences

By default, you will receive attendance notifications at the same phone number(s) you receive all other voice messages from Comsewogue School District. If you want to change these preferences, we suggest downloading the SchoolMessenger Home App. The email on file in SchoolTool will be used for the email version of the absence notification.

Viewing Messages in the SchoolMessenger Home App

Attendance notifications will continue to populate in the SchoolMessenger Home App just like the weekly calls from our building principals and Dr. Quinn. If you want to filter the messages only to view attendance messages, click the filter icon in the top right corner.
